Editorial

“The uncertainties created by flexibility, the lack of trust and dedication that have deep roots, the superficiality of group working and above all the threat of not being able to become someone in the society, of not "building up" through own work. All these conditions encourage people to look for attachment, belonging and depth somewhere else” (Sennet, 1999).

Talking about mentoring as a new methodology and construct, means brushing up and enhancing mechanisms of 'social communication' between 'parts' and 'differences' that always existed and which increasingly needed at all levels of the life of an individual. It means proposing old types of communication in current contexts in which the 'society of individuals' has become 'society at risk' (Beck U., 2008) of marginalization of individuals, minorities and differences.



The mentor, in fact, even before a figure whose functions are at the base of a methodology of development and support, personifies a role of socializing agent at multiple levels, a natural facilitator, an older friend, a passe partout for the world of adults, a continuous reference point. These are functions that in recent years with the advent and consolidation of the flexible society have been lost, and are returning to be requested by real people, by civil society, by the world of the School and University, by professional training and social and disadvantaged areas " (Perchiazzi, M. 2009).

Mentoring is a widespread methodology in the Anglo-Saxon world. In the last 5-7 years a lot has been done in Europe and in particular in Spain, France, Italy, Latvia, to introduce the mentoring methodology in different fields: social, companies, self-entrepreneurship, labor market, universities and schools.

IO2: Handbook: Extended Code of practice for conducting youth mentoring programme

The document in draft has been produced which will be finalized in English and translated into the respective languages by the end of 2018.

IO3: Self-assessment system for external validation as a part of a blended-assessment model

The objectives and production methods of the output have been defined. This activity will involve all the international working team that, by the end of November, will have to finalize the document in English, then proceed with the multilingual versions.

IO4: Android based mobile mentoring application to facilitate distance mentoring for youth with disabilities
